You can give the property outright, place it in trust to retain the use of it for life, or gift it by Will.

EXAMPLES OF PROPERTY YOU COULD DONATE:

- Real Estate: Houses, cottages, commercial buildings
- Personal Property: Jewelry, antiques, art, vehicles, collections
- **Principal Residence:** A charitable tax receipt is given for the fair market value which offsets other taxes on your Estate. There is no tax levied on the principal residence itself.
- Cottage or Other Real Estate: Revenue Canada levies tax on the capital gain of all other real estate assets. A charitable tax receipt can help to offset the tax on the gain as well as other taxes in your Estate.
